



## GVR Hunting and Fishing Club Club Purpose and Use of Funds Raised As of December 2023

***Club Purpose -- The primary purposes of the Club are to provide members the ability to meet socially, to learn about hunting and fishing opportunities in Arizona and Mexico, to share outdoor experiences, to promote hunting and fishing among area youth and to sponsor conservation projects in the greater Green Valley area.***

### The Club is actively involved in and has financially supported the following projects:

- **\$25,200** - Funding college scholarships for Sahuarita School District high schoolseniors pursuing wildlife, fish management, conservation, or related courses of study.
- **\$1,000** - Funding to Southern Arizona Quail Forever to support Family Day outdoor activities
- **\$1,000** - Help purchase a positive pressure breathing apparatus for use by the Green Valley Fire Department EMT staff on emergency calls during the pandemic.
- **\$3,500** - Support the air gun shooting, orienteering and ranger programs of the Sahuarita School District's Navy Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps program.
- **\$3,500** - Fund youth outreach (\$2,000) by Safari Club International Foundation and a youth hunting education camp (\$1,500) by the Arizona Safari Club chapter.
- **\$1,650** -- Fund the environmental education program, Trout in the Classroom, at Walden Grove High School. Trout eggs and fish tanks are provided while students and a participating teacher monitor and feed the eggs as they hatch and grow into fingerlings.
- **\$900** - Sponsor and fund travel expenses for two high school teachers from Sahuarita High School to attend a weeklong class in Jackson Hole, Wyoming to team about the outdoors and various activities relating to hunting, conservation, and their impact on the environment.
- **\$1,000** - Support family fishing events at Sahuarita Lake with emphasis on youth fishing.
- **\$500** - Sponsor a high school conservation club.
